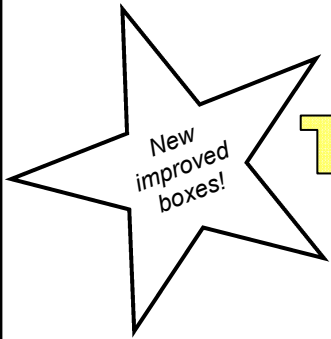

Take a look at the updated 'Learning' section at www.hertfordmuseum.org. You will find lots of information about visiting the museum, including downloadable documents to help you plan your visit, such as a teachers guide to the museum, risk assessments, gallery trails and much more.

What is available for my Class at Hertford Museum?

The ideas for these sessions came from consultation with local teachers and are open to change depending on your feedback. Sessions at the museum cost £1.50 per child for SG13 & SG14 schools, and £2.50 per child for all other schools. Outreach is charged at £50 per hour, with travel to and from your school subsidised by the Heritage Lottery Fund.



Session	Overview	Key Stage	Outreach?
Museum Safari	Spot colours, shapes and secret objects on a guided visit of the museum, handle objects and share a story.	FS & KS1	
Tilly's Toy Box	Meet Tilly and her selection of toys. Your class will play with real and replica toys and explore our toy display.	FS, KS 1 & KS2	Yes
Upstairs, Downstairs	Find out what it was <i>really</i> like to keep a home 'homely' before electricity, through object handling, role play and dressing up.	KS 1 & KS2	
Museum Detectives	Explore why museums exist and if they are important at all in a session that encourages critical thinking, evaluation skills and work with sources.	KS2	
Where in the World?	Using our African and world collections explore themes such as diversity, migration and citizenship.	KS1 & KS2	
Hertford's Home Front	A hands-on session exploring the lives of ordinary people in wartime Hertford, with real objects, documents and photographs.	KS 2 & KS3	Yes
Fossils!	Handle objects that are over 250 million years old with fun quizzes and games.	FS, KS 1 & KS2	Yes
Archaeology Detectives	Explore the archaeology collections now on display in Hertford Museum and take part in a 'blanket dig'.	KS1 & KS2	Yes
