Telephone the following people and connect them with a line to the correct fact about them

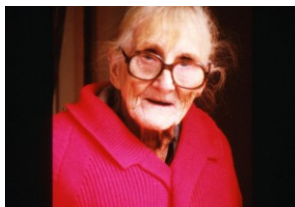


Number 5:  
Clement Attlee...



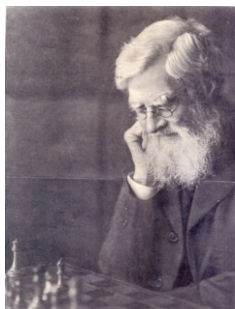
...went to Hertford Grammar School
