A Tour of the Clockmakers' Museum – a talk by Anna Rolls

Anna is Curator of the Worshipful Company of Clockmakers Museum and Archive. Moved from the Guildhall, London, it is now located within the Science Museum. Containing over a thousand watches as well as clocks, chronometers and other horological ephemera, the collection traces the history of London's clockmakers from the first chronometers to the wristwatch. Anna is an active member of the Antiquarian Horological Society.
